Abstract should briefly and quite informative summarize main ideas and received research results. Abstract’s size should consist of 150 to 250 words. Please note that the data on authors, title, keywords and abstract will be used as metadata to describe your article, so they should much as possible accurately describe its contents. To provide a better search of the content on the network, please avoid too generalized and complex language, use only well-known abbreviations. (10 pt.)

**Keywords:** term 1; term 2, term 3. (10 pt.)

## Article requirements

**Page:** A4.

**Page settings:** (margins): left – 3 cm.; right – 2 cm.; top – 2 cm.; bottom – 2 cm.

**Article font** – *Times New Roman*; regular; 10 pt.; spaced – 1.

**Article text** is located in two columns with the same width – 7,75 cm.; distance between columns – 0,5 cm.; first line indent – 0,5 cm.; alignment – the width.

**Subtitle** – 12 pt.; bold; no indent; alignment – the center.

**ATTENTION! The last page of an article must be filled with no less than on 3/4.**

**Formulas:** *MS Equation*, must be numbered.

In menu “*Size → Define*” enter the following sizes:

Full – 10 pt.;

Subscript – 8 pt.;

Sub-Subscript – 7 pt.;

Symbol – 15 pt.;

Sub-symbol – 9 pt.

In menu “*Style → Define*” fields “*Character Style*” – are empty.

**Tables** are numbered. The word “*Table 1*”, italic, right, 10 pt. Format of the **table name**: centered, bold, position – above the table. After the table it is necessary to leave a blank line.

**Figures** must be clear, centered, numbered and have a caption. Format of the Figure caption: centered, bold, position – under the Figure, 10 pt. Before and after Figure’s caption it should be left one blank line.

All in-text citations must be listed in the **reference** list in Roman script: (9 pt.).

- multiple sources are separated by comma [3, 5].

5. REFERENCES

Working languages – Ukrainian, Russian and English.

Article volume – from 3 to 10 pages in Ukrainian, Russian or English.
